Located on Interstate 10 Westbound Access Road
(Six-tenths of a mile west of Mile Marker 816)
Near Hankamer, Texas

James Taylor White

Born June 13, 1829
Died December 24, 1905

This is James Taylor "Jim" White II, son of James Taylor White and Sarah Cade

Sacred to the Memory Of

Amanda M.

Wife of James T. White

Born August 15, 1826
Died December 25, 1892
Aged 66 years, 4 months, 10 days

Amanda M. Speights, wife of James Taylor White II, was a daughter of Asa and Nancy Speights --- this appears to be correct, need more verification

Sarah B. Broussard

Born September 23, 1860
Died May 23, 1899

Sarah Bonetta White, first wife of Desire Louis Broussard, Sr.

Arthur Sampson Broussard

Son of D. L. and Sarah
Born October 16, 1895
Died June 4, 1896

Unmarked grave, a crypt

This may be the grave of Harold Broussard, an eight-month old son of Mr. and Mrs. J. E. Broussard, who died June 28, 1909 and was buried at the "White Cemetery a short distance out of town." (The Progress, July 2, 1909)

Additional notes: This cemetery is surrounded by an old cast iron fence and a substantial, but now quite rusted gate. The posts on either side of the gate carry inscriptions noting that they were built by the Champion Iron Company of Kenton, Ohio.
